Main Cybercrimes Main cybercrimes shall be punished by the Penal Code of Japan (Law No.45 of 1907, amended 1987) and the Unauthorized Computer Access Law (Law no. 128 of 1999). Most Cybercrimes defined in the Cybercrime Convention (ETS 185) are also punishable by the Penal Code.
