Latent effects of childhood lead exposure include chronic advanced renal disease or a reduction in renal function in adulthood. Impaired renal function and kidney disease are reported at high levels of lead exposure, as estimated mainly through concentrations of serum creatinine (SCR) and rates of creatinine clearance from the body.

Health Problems Caused by Lead. It does not matter if a person breathes-in, swallows, or absorbs lead particles, the health effects are the same; however, the body absorbs higher levels of lead when it is breathed-in. Within our bodies, lead is absorbed and stored in our bones, blood, and tissues.
